Liz McGowan teaches ancient Greek art and architecture, from the Bronze Age through the end of the Hellenistic period. Her classes include "Greek Art and Myth," the iconography of deities and heroes in ancient Greece, and "Body of Evidence," a survey of sculpture that considers changing concepts of the body from the Neolithic through the Hellenistic periods. She has taught seminars on Hellenistic sculpture, on sanctuaries, on ancient funerary art, and on monuments and memorials over time. Liz holds a B.A. from Princeton University and a Ph.D. from the Institute of Fine Arts.

# **POSITANO I AMALFI**

Coast. Experience this spectacular landscape on a fascinating ride along the serpentine coastline road. Visit the romantic, seemingly vertical town of Positano, perched along the mountainside over the sea. Then get another perspective from the water as you cruise in a private boat to the exquisite town of Amalfi. Admire the town's strikingly beautiful cathedral set atop a grand staircase, with the lively Piazza del Duomo nestled below.

**Local Flavor:** Savor a delicious "pranzo," or lunch, in Amalfi.

**Independent Exploration:** Make your own plans in Amalfi, and then return to Sorrento for more leisure time and dinner on your own.

#### **PAESTUM**

**Excursion:** *Mozzarella di Bufala.* At a local dairy farm, sample fresh mozzarella di bufala, a regional specialty made from the milk of the water buffalo. Its name derives from "mozzare," meaning "to cut off," which refers to the way pieces are cut to form the cheese's signature round shape.

**Excursion:** *Paestum.* Abandoned in the ninth century, this Greco-Roman city was overgrown by vegetation and forgotten for 1,000 years. The three stately Doric temples at this site represent some of the best-preserved examples outside of Greece.

**Local Flavor and Educational Focus:** *Meet the People.* Over lunch in Paestum, chat with



local residents about everyday Italian life.

# **Educational Focus:** The Wonders of Naples' Museo Archeologico Nazionale.

Before your upcoming excursion, discuss the art and artifacts of this internationally acclaimed museum.

**Local Flavor:** At dinner in Sorrento, enjoy Campania's wonderfully flavored cuisine.


#### **NAPLES**

**Excursion:** Naples and the Museo Archeologico Nazionale. Starting at the top of Posillipo Hill in Naples, embark on a panoramic tour of the city's historic center. Take in the sweeping view overlooking the city and the Bay of Naples, then see the Castel Nuovo, San Francesco di Paola, Teatro di San Carlo and Piazza del Plebiscito. Later, step back in time during your guided tour of the Museo Archeologico Nazionale, featuring a rich collection of Greek and Roman antiquities.


**Local Flavor:** At lunch, taste the famous Neapolitan pizza, prepared with the freshest local ingredients.

## **HERCULANEUM | POMPEII**

Excursion: Herculaneum and Pompeii.

Spend a full day exploring the cities of Herculaneum and Pompeii, destroyed by the eruption of Mount Vesuvius. The small seaside town of Herculaneum was preserved by mudflows while Pompeii, the larger of the two cities, was covered by ash. The resulting preservation of these two communities is unlike anything else in the world. See everything from mosaics to furniture and frescoes as you tour the Forum, baths and houses, and unearth a history lesson like no other.

**Local Flavor:** After exploring Herculaneum, stop for lunch in Pompeii before the second part of your excursion.


