# IMPORTANT ADDITIONAL INFORMATION ABOUT REUNION WEEKEND

- Registration. The reunion registration form is included in this packet. You can simply return the completed form with your check OR you can register and pay online using the college's secure server and your credit card at <a href="http://alumni.williams.edu/reunion">http://alumni.williams.edu/reunion</a>. Your user name is at the beginning of the letter accompanying this mailing, located under "25th Reunion Program" and your name. If you can't remember your password, go to <a href="http://tinyurl.com/ResetWilliamsPW">http://tinyurl.com/ResetWilliamsPW</a> to recover it. If the college has your email on file, you will also have received a personalized email with a direct link to the registration page online.
- Parking. Parking on campus can be a challenge during reunion. We suggest you park in the lot behind Thompson (the old Infirmary), in front of Poker Flats. If you are staying in the dorm, unload in the spaces along the north side of Mission and then move your car to the Thompson lot. If you do park elsewhere on campus, please pay attention to posted signs and time restrictions. Williamstown police will ticket violators.
- Housing. The Class of '94 will be housed at Mission Park, at \$80 per bed for the entire weekend. Sheets, a pillow, blanket and towel are provided. See the housing section of the reunion registration form for further details and to reserve a room. Rooms contain one single bed, but you may bring sleeping bags and an air mattress for a child or children to share your room at no additional cost. Babysitters attending reunion with your family are housed in the dorm at no cost. If you prefer to stay in a nearby hotel, a list is enclosed.
- **Dress.** Bring comfortable, casual clothes for the weekend. The Saturday evening reception and dinner are smart casual. Remember that the weather in Williamstown in June can vary greatly there is even the occasional downpour. It would be wise to check the forecast before you come! Keep in mind that our dinners will be on grass under a tent when selecting footwear.
- Golf. All tee times for play at Taconic must be reserved through classmate Rob Bice, our golf chair. Tee times are limited and will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. ## When you arrive on campus...

Sign in <u>only</u> at our Class Headquarters **in the lobby of Mission Park** (<u>not</u> at the Alumni Center as you did in previous years). Here is where you will officially register (the official class attendance counts are based on these numbers) and where you'll receive your welcome packet, your reunion gifts, and other important '94-specific information. If you are staying in the dorm, you'll also receive your dorm room key(s) at this time. We'll have a class message board at headquarters to help you connect with others more easily.

## Class registration headquarters will be open:

If you have reserved a room in the dorm and you arrive on campus after headquarters is closed, please go to Campus Security in Hopkins Hall, and they will let you in to your room. Please make sure to register at class headquarters the next morning.
